

The Board of Clark County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to adjournment in accordance with Section 121.22 O.R.C. (Sunshine Law) at the Commission Office, 50 East Columbia Street, Springfield, Ohio.

The following members and guests were present: Commissioner Richard L. Lohnes; Commissioner John Detrick; Commissioner David Herier; Nathan Kennedy, County Administrator; Megan Lokai, Clerk; Bonnie McHenry, New Carlisle News; Tiffany Latta, Springfield News Sun; John Federer, County Auditor; Tim Suter, First Energy.

Commissioner Lohnes called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

First Energy Transmission Line Project:

Tim Suter, First Energy, explained another transmission line project was planned. There will be a public meeting on May 25th at the Moorefield Township Office. It was a three phase project. Willow Road will be expanded. Two transmission lines will be tied in to the Willow Road substation. It was approximately a \$40 million project. This was separate from the London line. This project will tie into the line over by Buck Creek. The start date was December of 2017. See attached. The two routes that were chosen were the least intrusive. Commissioner Detrick wanted him to brief Moorefield Township. Mr. Suter said he went last night to brief them. Most of the lines will hopefully be on the edge of farm fields.

Agenda Review:

Commissioner Detrick asked about the following resolutions:

Resolution 2016-0235: He felt it was good to have businessmen talking with other businessmen because it created a better understanding of the issues. He wished the whole county would go with the CIC which would present a unified effort. This contract gives Clark County a bigger voice. Commissioner Lohnes added dirt was moving at Prime Ohio II. Love's was getting the project going.

Resolution 2016-0236: Commissioner Detrick asked about the local companies. Mr. Kennedy stressed the Board cannot give preferential treatment. JFS went through the RFP process and this was who was chosen.

Resolution 2016-0237: Commissioner Detrick said this was a great program. The number was lower than last year. Mr. Kennedy noted the amount of weeks for the program was shorter. They still get OSHA training.

Resolution 2016-0241: He spoke highly of the money saved bidding this. He gave kudos to staff.

Resolution 2016-0246: He asked if there was a change in the guidelines for poverty levels. Mr. Kennedy said it did not change the poverty levels. They were minor updates.
