Narrative

On the afternoon of November 29, 2016 a student at Kenton Ridge High School reported finding a note in the restroom. The note had an unspecified threat that the school decided to look further in to. Kenton Ridge High School immediately made contact with the Clark County Sheriff's Office to assist them in investigating this unspecified threat. During the investigation it was determined that there was not an immediate threat at the school so deputies continued to develop new information.

On the morning of November 30, 2016 the Clark County Sheriff's Office arrived at Kenton Ridge High School to conduct a pre-scheduled search of the school with assistance of K9's from the Wright Patterson Air Force Base. During the search of the school nothing was located however a juvenile female was brought down to the office for further questioning in reference to the unspecified threat.

While talking with the student information was received that she was the one responsible for the prior unspecified threat. Once evidence was gathered the student was charged with one count of Disorderly Conduct per the Clark County Prosecutors Office. The juvenile was released to her parent and she will be ordered in to Clark County Juvenile Court.
