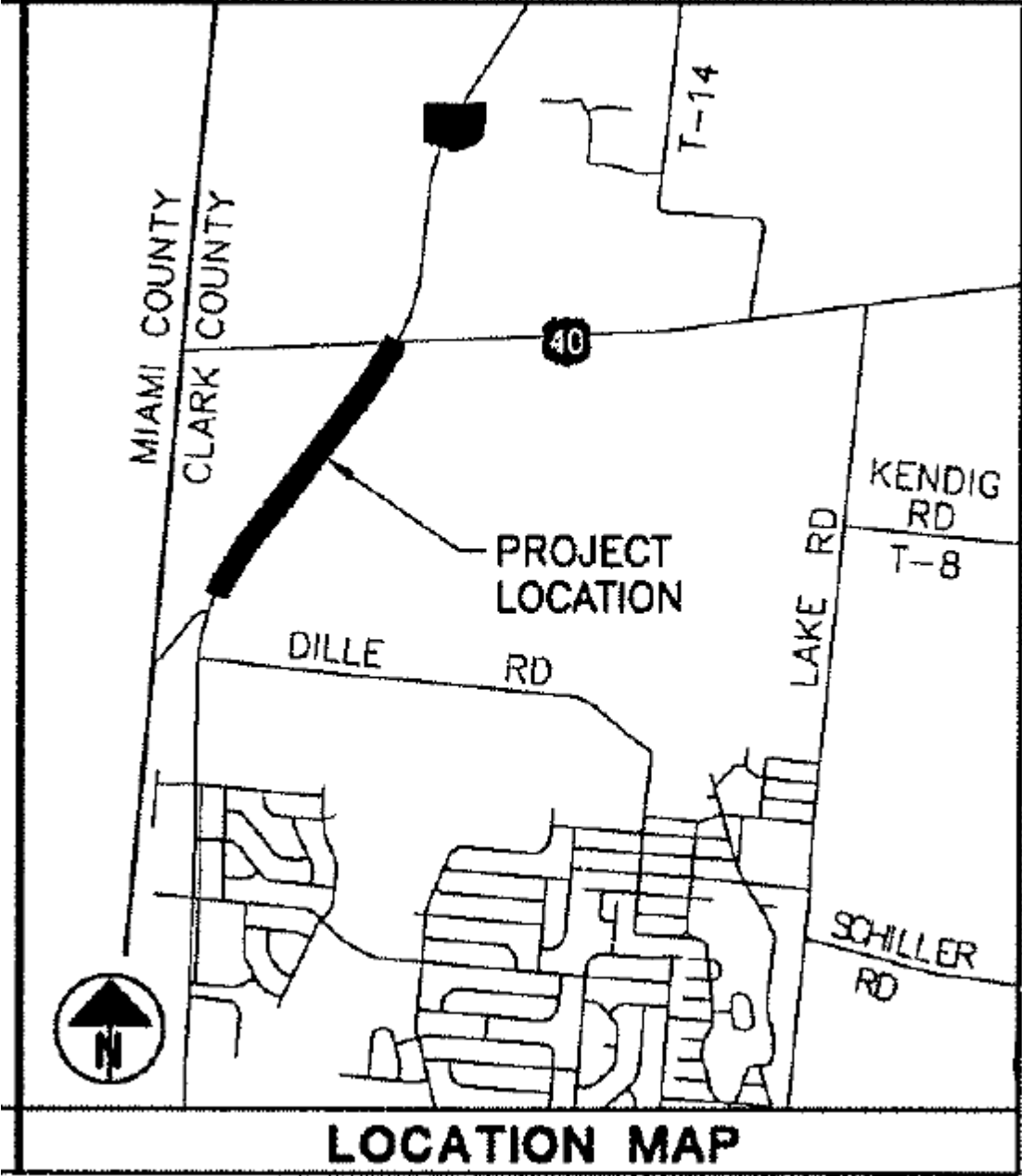

WHEREAS, the National Trail Parks and Recreation District is a special a Joint Recreation District – organized under Chapter 755 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,

WHEREAS, the National Trail Parks and Recreation District maintains parks, greenspaces and trails and provides recreational services to the residents of Clark County Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Section 755.14(8)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the City Commission and the Board of County Commissioners, by resolution, may establish a joint recreation board which possesses all the powers and is subject to all the responsibilities of the respective local authorities under Sections 755.12 to 755.18 of the Ohio Revised Code and the National Trail Parks and Recreation District was formed as such a joint recreation district for Clark County; and,

WHEREAS, this County Commission did enact Resolution 806-99, adopted September 14, 1999, as amended by Resolution No. 393-02, adopted May 14, 2002, Resolution No. 188-06, adopted February 28, 2006, Resolution 178-07, adopted February 20, 2007 in which it provided for the establishment of a joint recreation district; and,

WHEREAS, the Clark County Commission has determined that the dissolution of the District would be in the best interests of all of the citizens of Clark County and hereby votes to dissolve the National Trail Parks and Recreation District effective December 31, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, that effective December 31, 2023 that the National Trail Parks and Recreation District be dissolved.

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of Elderly United of Springfield and Clark County, Ohio, Inc., dba United Senior Services has reported and certified to the Board of County Commissioners, Clark County, Ohio, that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitations by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the subdivision, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of making appropriations for providing or maintaining senior citizen services or facilities in Clark County, as authorized by O.R.C. Sections 307.694 and/or 307.85; and,

WHEREAS, Elderly United of Springfield and Clark County, Ohio, Inc. dba United Senior Services has requested that a renewal levy be on the ballot for the November 2023 general election for the purpose of making appropriations for providing or maintaining senior citizen services or facilities in Clark County and further requested that a one and four-tenths (1.4) mills renewal levy for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2024 and first collected in calendar year 2025, be placed on the November 7, 2023 ballot for the purpose of providing or maintaining services or facilities for older adults; spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities; and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to older adults; and,

WHEREAS, the necessary levy of one and four tenths (1.4) mills for each dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, be in effect for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2024 and first collected in calendar year 2025; and that the question of levying said tax to be submitted to the electorate of Clark County Ohio, at the general election to be held on November 7, 2023, as provided in O.R.C. 5705.19 (Y) and 5705.191.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03, 5705.19 and 5705.191, and further authorize submission of a request to the Auditor for a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Revenue to be generated from one and four-tenths (1.4) mills renewal levy for a period of five (5) years, beginning levy in 2024 and collected with tax year 2025 through tax year 2029, for providing funds for providing or maintaining senior citizens' services or facilities, spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities, and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to senior citizens by and through United Senior Services.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this levy will appear on the November 7, 2023 ballot for the entire territory of Clark County.

Commissioner ____ moved, per the request of Executive Director of Elderly United of Springfield and Clark County, Inc. dba United Senior Services, to adopt the following resolution proposing the submission of renewal levy of 1.40 mills for providing or maintaining senior citizens' services or facilities, spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities, and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to senior citizens in Clark County, Ohio; and authorizing the Clerk to certify a copy of said resolution to the Board of Elections, for placement on the November 7, 2023 Ballot.

Resolution

The Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Ohio, declares, after careful examination of the records of Clark County, Ohio, that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitations by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient contribution to senior services, and that it is necessary to levy additional taxes in excess of such limitation for providing or maintaining senior citizens' services or facilities, spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities, and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to senior citizens in Clark County, as authorized by O.R.C. Sections 307.694 and/or 307.85.

Be it therefore resolved, that the Board of Commissioners of Clark County hereby approves renewal levy of 1.40 mills, for providing or maintaining senior citizens' services or facilities, spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities, and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to senior citizens in Clark County, Ohio, pursuant to O.R.C. Section 5705.19(Y) and 5705.191;

Be it further resolved, that said additional levy shall constitute a tax of 1.40 mills, for providing or maintaining senior citizens' services or facilities, spending moneys for the support of such services or facilities, and giving financial assistance to, and cooperating with, not for profit, private organizations in establishing and operating programs to provide services to senior citizens by and through United Senior Services, or its successor in name, as authorized by O.R.C. Sections 307.694 and/or 307.85, said rate not exceeding 1.40 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to forty-nine dollars (\$49) for each one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of valuation for a period of five (5) years, as follows: 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, and 2028 to be collected in calendar years 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029;

Be it further resolved, that said election on this additional levy shall be held on November 7, 2023.

It is further resolved, that this resolution shall become effective upon passage.

It is further resolved, that the tax will be levied upon the entire territory of Clark County.

Be it resolved, that publication of notice of said election shall be made in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the county, once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the election. The notice shall state the purpose, the proposed levy in rates express in dollars and cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, as well as in mills for each one dollar of valuation, the number of years during which such levy will be in effect and the time and place of the election.

Be it further resolved, that the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to certify a copy of the resolution to the Board of Elections of Clark County, Ohio, in the manner provided by Sections 5705.19 and 5705.25 Revised Code of Ohio.

Commissioner ____ moved to acknowledge the Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties levy renewal request.

WHEREAS, the CEO of Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties has reported and certified to the Board of County Commissioners, Clark County, Ohio, that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitations by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the subdivision, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of making appropriations for providing funds for operation of community mental health services providers and addiction services providers and the acquisition, construction, renovation financing, maintenance, and the operation of mental health facilities and addiction facilities by and through the Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties; and,

WHEREAS, Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties has requested that a renewal levy be on the ballot for the November 2023 general election for the purpose of making appropriations for providing funds for operation of community mental health services providers and addiction services providers and the acquisition, construction, renovation financing, maintenance, and the operation of mental health facilities and addiction facilities by and through the Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties, and further requested that a one and sixty-five tenths (1.65) mills renewal levy for a period of ten (10) years, commencing in 2024 and first collected in calendar year 2025, be placed on the November 7, 2023 ballot; and,

WHEREAS, the necessary levy of one and sixty-five tenths (1.65) mills for each dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, be in effect for a period of ten (10) years, commencing in 2024 and first collected in calendar year 2025; and that the question of levying said tax to be submitted to the electorate of Clark County Ohio, at the general election to be held on November 7, 2023, as provided in O.R.C. 5705.221.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.03, 5705.221, 5705.19, and 5705.191, and further authorize submission of a request to the Auditor for a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Revenue to be generated from one and sixty-five tenths (1.65) mills renewal levy for a period of ten (10) years, beginning levy in 2024 and collected with tax year 2025 through tax year 2034, for providing funds for operation of community mental health services providers and addiction services providers and the acquisition, construction, renovation financing, maintenance, and the operation of mental health facilities and addiction facilities by and through the Mental Health Recovery Board of Clark, Greene, and Madison Counties.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this levy will appear on the November 7, 2023 ballot for the entire territory of Clark County.
