

The Board of Clark County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to adjournment in accordance with Section 121.22 O.R.C. (Sunshine Law) in the Commission Chambers, 3130 East Main Street, Springfield, Ohio.

The following members and guests were present: Commissioner Melanie F. Wilt; Commissioner Lowell R. McGlothin; Commissioner Sasha L. Rittenhouse; Jennifer Hutchinson, County Administrator; Michelle Noble, Assistant County Administrator/Human Resources Director; Angela Wheeler, Commission Clerk; Beau Thompson, Assistant County Prosecutor; Michael Cooper, Public Information Officer; Tom O'Neal and Ron Coss, Veterans Service Commission; Sydney Dawes, Springfield News Sun.

Commissioner Wilt called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

*Agenda Review:*

Ms. Hutchinson reviewed the agenda.

Resolution 2023-0078 authorized contract with Fazio Color Shop, Inc. on behalf of the Buildings and Grounds Director for as needed floor covering, window blinds, and installation.

Resolution 2023-0079 authorized contract amendment #3 with Northwoods Consulting Partners, Inc. on behalf of Job and Family Services to extend the contract for an additional year. This contract is to provide Gold Level Software maintenance and support.

Resolution 2023-0080 authorized law enforcement contract with Mad River Township on behalf of the Sheriff's Office. Commissioner Wilt said she would like to note the Sheriff's Office covers the County as a whole but the contract ensures there is a deputy in the location at all times. Commissioner Rittenhouse asked if this contract is one the County has every year. Ms. Hutchinson verified it is.

Resolution 2023-0081 authorized Fire and EMS Dispatching contract with Harmony Township.

Resolution 2023-0082 instructed Clerk to advertise for bids for New Carlisle Smith Park Year-Round Shelter House Project on behalf of Community and Economic Development. This is CDBG project funds for COVID. Commissioner McGlothin asked if this is the normal time given for bids. Ms. Hutchinson said yes, it is usually two (2) weeks.

Resolution 2023-0083 authorized grant submission to Office of Criminal Justice Services on behalf of the Sheriff's Office. This grant addresses firearm related crimes and forensics through the establishment of a Crime Gun Intelligence Center.

Resolution 2023-0084 accepted grant agreement with Office of Criminal Justice Services on behalf of the Sheriff's Office for retention bonuses and violence reduction. The Sheriff's Office was successful in receiving this grant.

Resolution 2023-0085 authorized acceptable Use Policy for Clark County Public Safety Users. This is the new system for the 9-1-1 Dispatch. The policy defines what is acceptable and not acceptable. Commissioner Wilt said she reviewed the policy and as a matter of procedure for us, the County might need to update the cloud-based programs to allow for shared users for things such as Zoom. Mr. Cooper said we are currently working on items for shared users. Commissioner Wilt said she also wondered about Section 4.1, 2, the use of the term 'highly discouraged'. She said County employees should never be using work computers for personal reasons. Ms. Noble commented that the County has issued disciplines for personal use of County computers. Commissioner Wilt said the policy should note that it refers to the Personnel Manual. Ms. Noble said the Sheriff's Office has their own HR handbook. Mr. Thompson said this policy would also apply to the township and city employees who

are using the 9-1-1 dispatch system. It is not just County employees. Commissioner Wilt verified this policy is only for Public Safety system use. Ms. Hutchinson confirmed it is. Commissioner Wilt said this policy is very important to have in place.

Resolution 2023-0086 approved payment #8 to ArmCorp Construction, Inc. for the Home Road Renovation project.

Ms. Hutchinson explained four (4) funds have insignificant balances so the County is closing these funds and moving the balances (\$5.31) to the general fund. Ms. Hutchinson said she is not sure if a resolution is necessary but thought it is the best way to handle the closures.

Resolution 2023-0090 authorized salary and wage adjustments. Ms. Hutchinson said the County will backdate the increase to the first full pay period in January. This is for non-union employees.

Resolution 2023-0091 approved issuance of warrants for then and nows.

Resolution 2023-0092 acknowledged and certified the County's total road mileage certification of 308.022 for the year 2022. Commissioner Wilt said this should be the same mileage as last year minus the County roads that were vacated.

Resolution 2023-0093 re-appointed Jo Anderson to the County Planning Commission. Her new expiration date will be December 2025. Jo Anderson works part-time at the dog shelter. Discussion ensued.

Resolution 2023-0094 authorized placement on Tax Duplicate for uncollected water and sewer use charges on behalf of the Utilities Director.

Resolution 2023-0095 approved travel/expense allowances for the week.

#### *Commissioner Updates:*

Commissioner McGlothin said he went to Indianapolis with his son and two grandsons for hockey. They had a good time.

Commissioner Rittenhouse said she went to Springfield-Clark CTC for a tour. They are doing neat things there. They are going in the technical field direction. It is great the kids can start in high school and she appreciates what they are doing for our community.

Commissioner Rittenhouse went to Columbus and met with representatives and Chief Justice Kennedy. She also met with Senator Hackett and Representative Willis. She met the Agriculture Chair and Director of Agriculture.

#### *County Administrator Updates:*

Ms. Hutchinson said there was a Directors Meeting yesterday. The County still has several openings in various departments. The County will have a shred day in the spring. It will be at Springview. The Re-Entry Director is working on the software for case management. She is also writing more grant applications. The Dog Warden still

has several dogs at the shelter. There are many aggressive dogs. A woman was attacked by a pack of dogs. Ms. Click is meeting with the Police and Sheriff's Department to discuss procedures. There is more retail coming to the community. Panda Express will be in front of Kohls on Bechtle and Chipotle on South Limestone. Skyline will be coming to Clark County.

Ms. Hutchinson said the County still has several projects going on. Mr. Swank is getting estimates on the jail mezzanine. They are finishing security badges at Springview and the Courthouse.

Mr. Cooper is finalizing the Annual Report. He is still waiting for a few more departments to send in their information.

Job and Family Services said the Public Health Crisis is ending and the public will no longer receive the extra funding. Commissioner Wilt asked if we would have specific case managers to help people transition through that change. Ms. Hutchinson said they would be able to contact case managers.

Commissioner McGlothlin said the TCC meeting is Friday.

Commissioner Wilt said she went to the kick-off of the Interstate 70 interchange traffic study. They are also looking at 41 and 40. She said it sounds like there is a potential of an even larger truck stop in that area. She said the engineering group TCC hired seemed to be very competent.
