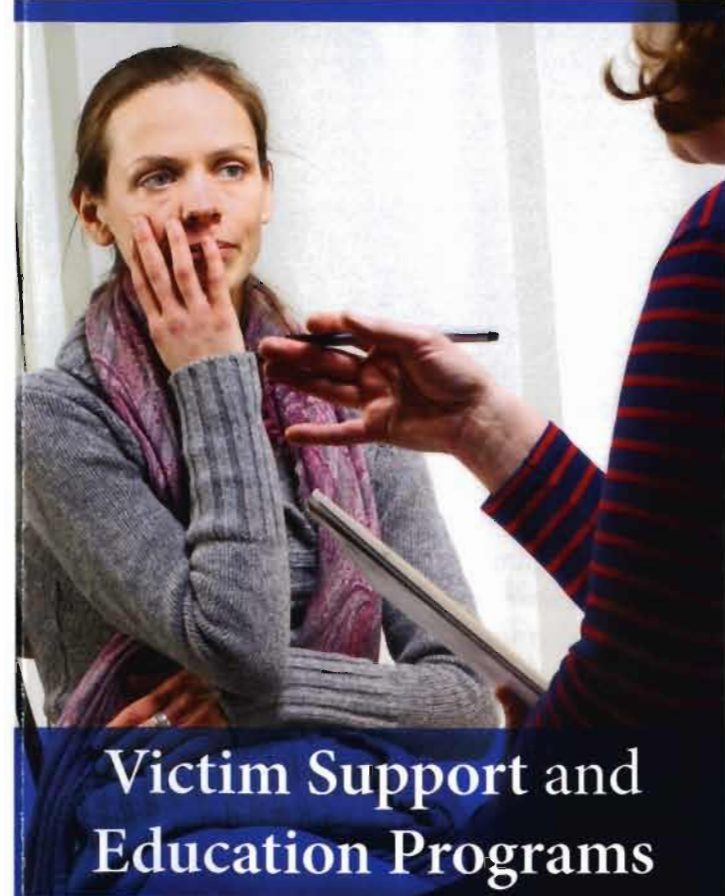

Rapid Response & Cole's Warriors



The Clark County Prosecutor's Office / Victim Witness have designed specialized supportive and educational services for citizens of Clark County whose lives have been touched by crime. These programs include two rapid response teams that provide services immediately following incidents of violent crimes. The teams work primarily with victims / witnesses of life threatening assault, sexual assault, domestic violence, and family / witnesses to homicide. The Prosecutor's Office / Victim Witness is also dedicated to educating the community about the dangers of prescription drug misuse. We have come alongside the Cole's Warriors program in drug abuse education and prevention. Through these programs Cole's Warriors has instituted drug take back boxes in three Clark County locations, a high school drug screening program, and anonymous Tipsubmit program.

Rapid Response

The Rapid Response Violent Crimes program is designed to assist victims from the crime scene through the disposition of the criminal case. This program is an effort coordinated by the Clark County Prosecutor's Office in collaboration with the Springfield Police Department and Clark County Sheriff's Office.

Rapid response advocates provide:

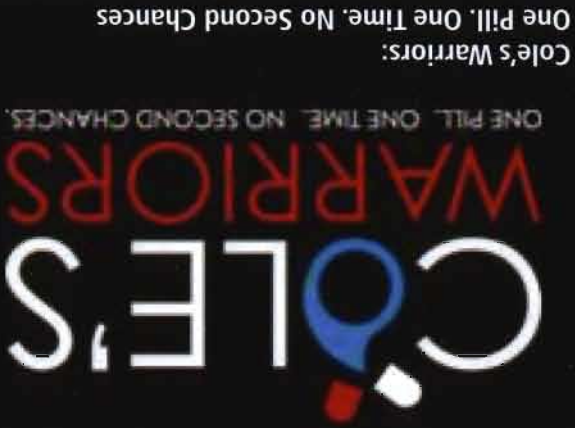
- Immediate crisis support / education about trauma Assistance with funeral arrangements
- Coordinating and linking to available community resources

- Communication with detectives Assistance in Applying for Victims of Crime Compensation

- Support / Advocacy in any meetings or court proceedings Support and education groups for survivors of homicide



Cole's Warriors



Cole's Warriors is a drug prevention and education program formed in response to the passing of 16 year old Cole Smoot. This is a partnership program with Family and Youth Initiatives. Cole's Warriors is currently partnering with local city and county schools with a voluntary drug screening program. This program is free of charge and is monitored by Cole's Warriors. Also established is the Tipsubmit program where citizens can anonymously report drug activity to law enforcement for further investigation. This tip program has led to several drug seizures in Clark County.

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
